

CURRICULUM VITAE

Mauricio L. Barreto completed his Medical Studies and a Master in Public Health, both at Federal University of Bahia(UFBa), Salvador, Brazil. In 1987, he was awarded a Ph.D. from the London School of Hygiene and Tropical Medicine. He's a Professor of Collective Health Epidemiology at UFBa and a Senior Investigator at Oswaldo Cruz Foundation. He leads a large and active research group studying poverty-related infectious diseases, allergy and asthma, the environmental and social determinants of health, health inequalities, and the evaluation of the impact of population-based health and social interventions on health. Recently he setup the Center for Data and Knowledge Integration for Health-CIDACS where is housed the "100 million Brazilians cohort" aimed to evaluate the impact of social protections programs on health using linkage of large administrative databases. He was a leader organizer of the Lancet Series on Brazil, published in 2011. He has published over 400 peer reviewed papers and has supervised 22 successful PhDs students. He is an elected fellow of the Brazilian Academy of Sciences(ABC) and the World Academy of Sciences(TWAS) and an Honorary Professor at the LSHTM-UK.
